- Women are the greatest gift that God has given to men! Prov. 19:14 House and wealth are a heritage from fathers, but a wife with good sense is from the Lord.




- Because of the nurturing nature of women, the enemy targets them in an effort to draw them away from the safety of their covering. The father of their children (husband) is designated as their covering, but the enemy desires to remove this protection. ITim. 2:14 And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression.
- The covering of the woman gives her contentment. This attribute protects her from being attracted to things that will hinder her role as the nurturer of her children and help meet of her husband. Is. 49:15 Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee.
- When wives are properly covered by their husbands, they are content with their creation role. But, when men do not properly cover their wives, she will be attracted to things that will ultimately bring shame to her. *Prov. 29:15 The rod and sharp words give wisdom: but a child who is not guided is a cause of shame to his mother.*



- The devil's job is to lure the wife away from the covering of her husband by making her purpose seem mundane and unfulfilling. Gen. 3:6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.
- The husband's job is to protect his wife from the opinions of others and keep her content with her position in the home. The influence of society, family, etc. are all used by the enemy to make money, goals, and knowledge more attractive that what she is created for. Luke II:21 When a strong man armed keepeth his palace, his goods are in peace:
- When there is a godly mother present in the home, she will desire to protect her home from outside influences. Her husband and her children will always come first!

 Prov. 31:27 She looks well to how things go in her household, and the bread of idleness (gossip, discontent, and self-pity) she will not eat.



summary

Our society paints a morbid picture of motherhood.
