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- Our society seeks to demean the authority of men. The creation of the LGBT agenda is to weaken the appearance of the man. *Rom. 1:27 And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet.*
- When men support the LGBT movement, they are supporting their own extermination and promoting the power of women. *1Cor. 6:9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,*
- God made man the head, so Satan desires to reverse this order and place the woman in authority over the home, workplace and even the nation (presidency). *1Cor. 11:3 But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God.*





- Being the head of the woman means that men should lead their homes financially, spiritually, emotionally, and with their physical strength, when necessary (protection, child discipline). ***Luke 11:21 When a strong man armed keepeth his palace, his goods are in peace:***
- The order that God established keeps the home balanced, so the children can have a clear understanding of their roles. When the roles of the home are defined and displayed, the children will grow up desiring the same order. ***Eph. 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.***
- Men must lead their homes with concern for the future of their children. Proper investments always yield good returns. ***Prov. 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.***

- Just as God leads us day by day and instructs us to not worry about tomorrow, the home should be governed more by what is needed now versus what will happen in the future. *Matt. 6:34 Then have no care for tomorrow: tomorrow will take care of itself. Take the trouble of the day as it comes.*
- Good leadership is reflected by a father ensuring that his family is intact. No one is perfect, but every good father strives to line up his home correctly. *Phil. 3:14 I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.*
- A father makes sure his wife and children are protected from society's definition of the home. A good father sticks to God's plan and stays the course, no matter what! *2John 9 For if you wander beyond the teaching of Christ, you will not have fellowship with God. But if you continue in the teaching of Christ, you will have fellowship with both the Father and the Son.*



SUMMARY

Our society is against traditional marriage. Even when they support marriage, they push the idea of both parents working to provide for the future of their children. Their desire is for women to leave the home and join the workplace. They push mothers to go after promotions, seek fulfillment in the workplace, and encourage women to have “their own money” as a safety net just in case the man leaves them. Presently, they are even trying to draft women into the armed forces to pull them away from their children for good. They consider these actions as necessary to invest in the child’s future by saving up for college and other things.
