Bad marriages, bad children, bad decisions, etc. cause men to seek the approval of strangers to vindicate themselves. They are pride driven in most cases because instead of making changes to help heal their past errors, they cover them up with the applause of people that do not truly know them. *Prov. 29:2 ¶ When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice: but when the wicked beareth rule, the people mourn.*

They have made terrible choices in life and their bad decisions haunt them. They want to feel like there is hope, so they place their hope in the election process.
