


## Trees 8

- Good trees bear fruit that will sow good seeds. Seeds are the beginning of a thing that contains the information that it will grow into. Gen. 1:11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.
- Although seeds need good conditions to grow, what it will grow into is dictated by the type of seed it is. Gen. 1:12 And the earth brought forth grass, and herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed was in itself, after his kind: and God saw that it was good.
- Fruit passes information to the seed, whether good or bad. We bear fruit of ourselves and produce seeds that will replicate us, but more plentifully. Gal. 6:8 For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.





- When we sow seed, we must ensure that we are saying and doing the right things in the process. Our words and actions formulate the information in the seed. Gal. 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
- For example, our children will usually become what we say to them; not only when we are speaking good to them, but also when we speak evil to them or around them. *Eph. 4:29 Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.*
- The power of a believer to speak things into existence is real, especially when it concerns death and life. Our tongues can fashion our reality. *Prov.* 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.



 Planting the seed of the Word in our children and loved ones will help them to grow into what the seed contains. The Word can form their reality and help them to overcome issues in their lives. 1Pet. 2:2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:

 When we proclaim the Word and trust in God, we can alter the very mindset of others. The Word of God is so powerful, that it can cut away negativity and alter the will of a person. Heb. 4:12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

• What we plant will always grow, so we must be sure to speak God's plan over our family, friends and loved ones. Our word is a seed, just like God's Word is a seed. We must be certain that our words line up with His words. *Is. 59:21 As for me, this is my covenant with them, saith the LORD; My spirit that is upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, not out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and for ever.* 







Seeds contain the building blocks of our existence. The definition of a seed is a mature fertilized ovule of angiosperms and gymnosperms that contain an embryo and the food it will need to grow into a new plant. Basically, a seed feeds off itself in the beginning stages. The seed has been given the information that will shape its identity. It will feed off what was given to it by the fruit that it came from. We must be very careful that we are sowing the right things so that when our fruit grows, it will have good seed for good trees. The planting ground and climate conditions may be favorable for growth, but if the seed lacks vital information for progression, it will still have growth challenges.

A seed can only grow into whatever information it contains. The Bible is adamant about speaking, saying, and proclaiming the right things because we can alter the seed's existence by speaking against it instead of speaking life to it. Hearing and believing the Word of God provides good seeds which will always ensure its growth into a fruit-bearing tree.





Matt. 12:33 Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit. Matt. 12:34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. Matt. 12:35 A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.
