

Good Mothers

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- Women were created for a specific purpose according to the Word of God. They were made to be help meets for a man. Gen. 2:18 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.
- In order to have purpose, a woman must be working toward the goal of being a readily available help meet. Titus 2:5 To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.
- > Fathers and mothers must teach their daughters how to care for their own homes so when their time comes they will be prepared to deny themselves and focus on their family. Prov. 6:20 My son, keep thy father's commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother:





- When parents do not condition their daughters to do this, it can be harder for them to acclimate to their role in their home. Prov. 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame.
- Many women do not find fulfillment in their husband and children, so they seek after validation outside of their homes, leaving their children to struggle to find their purpose. Prov. 31:31 Give her of the fruit of her hands; and let her own works praise her in the gates.
- Abandonment and neglect creates a cycle of discontentment and can cause the children to have frivolous relationships, insecurities, and issues that complicate their lives. *Prov.* 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

- Women are the nourishers of their homes, but in order to nourish others, she must be content with her situation. Heb. 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- The desire to see her family do well satisfies a good mother. What people think of her should be solely based on her home and not superficial achievements. Prov. 31:27 She looketh well to the ways of her household, and eateth not the bread of idleness.
- A good mother knows that pleasing God comes from pleasing her husband and caring for her children. Being a help meet is her ultimate purpose because it is what she was created for. Prov. 31:28 Her children arise up, and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praiseth her.



SUMMARY

The unnatural desire of women to be self-focused instead of focusing on the needs of their own home, has wrecked havoc on society. Today, many women are married with children while still seeking validation and affirmation from things outside of their homes. When women seek approval for superficial things, they cannot focus on their husbands or children.
