



No matter how you came to be, whether you were born in a happy marriage or in a time of crisis, God has a plan for you. Jer. 1:5 Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.


Our culture tries to injure you before you can find God's plan for your life. Society targets your future through entertainment, social media, and peer pressure, so that it will not line up with God's purpose for you. 1John 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

- ➤ The devil tries to violate you sexually so you will have sexual dysfunction in your life. This may cause you to have children out of wedlock, harm your chances of getting married or staying married, or have a negative perspective of the opposite sex. 1Cor. 6:18 Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.
- Through these violations, the enemy wants to plant seeds of doubt in you at an early age that will cause you to distrust God's plan. Sin causes us to doubt our very existence and makes us feel expendable and useless. Rom. 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.



Even though we may be injured by the actions of others, we are still accountable for our own actions. Our path is our path and we must walk it out no matter what comes our way. Phil. 3:13 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,


