Be thankful for the things that you have

- We must always give thanks to God for all that He has allowed us to possess. 1Chr. 16:8 Give thanks unto the LORD, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people.
- Most of us have an abundance of food and clothing. We should feel grateful and blessed to have them. 1Tim. 6:8 And having food and raiment let us be therewith content.
- To show thankfulness for what we have, we should always give away a portion of it. Even the things we like and desire should be given away at times, just to show how thankful we are. Luke 6:38 Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.



Be thankful for like minded believers to fellowship with

- Today, many people aren't fortunate to fellowship with like-minded believers. Even in their own churches, they may not have sound doctrine or true believers to draw strength from. Heb. 10:25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Knowing those that labor among you is essential in producing a true Godly lineage. 1Th. 5:12 And we beseech you, brethren, to know them which labour among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you;
