Faith in your marriage

- **We must believe that God is love and by His love, all sins can be forgiven. In order for any marriage to last, forgiveness and unconditional love must be established. *1Cor. 13:7 Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.***
- **It takes faith to believe God for a marriage. Faith that it will last. Faith that things will get better. Faith that God put it together and He will keep it together. Faith that no matter what happens, it can be worked out. *James 1:6 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.***



Faith in your singleness - Female

- **You must have faith as single women that God knows you and sees you. Your desire for marriage is His desire but faith will allow Him opportunity to work on you. During your waiting period, you must remain close to Him. *1Cor. 7:34 There is difference also between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please her husband.***
- **Faith will cause you to believe in truth without modifying it to fit your desire. When you have real, tried faith, you will accept the truth and apply it so that you will be ready when a proper suitor comes along. *James 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.***



Faith in your singleness - Male

- **As men, you must have faith that your choice for a wife is God's choice for you. Because God knows the future, you must depend on His foresight! The closer you are to Him, the better you will see through Him. *Prov. 19:21 Many are the plans in the mind of a man, but it is the purpose of the LORD that will stand.***
- **Faith requires works to prove itself. When you are believing God for a wife, you must do work in preparation for it. A man that does not know who he is or what he will be can come to God for a wife. Why would God bless you with someone if you are not secure in who you are? *James 2:20 But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?***



Faith in your healing

- **The Bible tells us that some sicknesses come from sin and some come as testing. Some come as birth defects and some are onset by lifestyle choices, etc. But faith is faith. In order for us to acquire the gift of healing, we must have faith in the source of healing and many times we must understand the reasoning so we can be preventive as well. *Matt. 9:22 But Jesus turned her about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.***
- **Believing God for healing takes faith. Will everyone be healed? No. But everyone that is sick should believe and trust God with the condition of their bodies. *Psa. 103:2-3 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;***



Faith in your provision

- **Praying for money is not biblical. But believing God for ways to make money is definitely scriptural. God can bless the work of our hands and help us to be exalted on our jobs through His divine favor. God loves to place His beings in strategic positions to allow for the blessings of others. *Job 1:10 Hast not thou made an hedge about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side? thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land.***
- **Giving and hard work are required for financial blessing. We can have faith, but we must have the works of sowing so that men will give to us. Hard work and diligence will never go unnoticed. *Prov. 13:4 The soul of the sluggard desireth, and hath nothing: but the soul of the diligent shall be made fat.***



Faith in your deliverance

- **People that cannot stay delivered lacked faith in their deliverance. When we truly believe that God has delivered us from the hand of the enemy, we must make sure we are not jumping back in his grip. The path that leads back to our issues will always resurface. It's not that we weren't delivered, but it's that we wandered back into it. *Gal. 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.***
- **Faith keeps us believing that we do not have to go back. When we see the pathway that leads to destruction, by faith we can resist it and keep walking in our deliverance. *James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.***



SUMMARY

Whatever you are believing God for, you must believe until you receive it. Having true faith requires a true commitment to stand and trust God until you have what it is you were believing for. No matter what it is, if it's in His will, you can receive it. While waiting, learn His will for you and implement all of His will, not just the part that pertains to what you want to receive. God uses the time of waiting to not only teach patience, but to clean up the rest of your life in preparation for what you are believing Him for.

Many people miss what they are believing for because they will not line the rest of their lives up with God's will. We cannot just ask for one thing in His will without living in His will completely. We must align our lives with His desires for our lives in order to receive what we are asking Him for. This is tried faith at its finest. Seeking His kingdom and His righteousness will always add the things we are believing for.

Mark 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

Mark 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Mark 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.
