

• In order to align our lives to God's way, we must examine each part of our being. 1Th. 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.


• God sanctifies every part of our being to bring us peace. However, we must be open to receive it and allow Him access to every part. Is. 26:3 Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

• To correct what is wrong, we must go deep into the foundation of our being to break up the stony issues that are hidden within. *Mark 4:5 And some fell on stony ground, where it had not much earth; and immediately it sprang up, because it had no depth of earth:*





- Our spirit is what we use to perceive God and commune with Him. This part of our being connects us with Him. Job 32:8 But there is a spirit in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty give th them understanding.
- Demon spirits attempt to connect with our spirit to block our communion with God. They attempt to mimic God and must be tried in order to be discovered. 17ohn 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
- The Word of God provides guidance on trying spirits to see where they come from. This is how we know what's from God or not. 170hn 4:6 We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.



• The soul is the sphere of man's will and emotions. It is the consciousness that will live after our physical death. Ezek. 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.


- Our soul/mind/consciousness gets corrupted by evil thoughts and desires. Our decision making is hindered when our soul is not fully yielded to God. Rom. 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Our body's condition will be the result of our communion with God and our soul's desires. Our body obeys the ruler of our spirit and soul. Rom. 6:16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?







Correction starts with examining our total being. Ensuring that we have a clear path to God is the first step in correcting the things that are not in line with Him. We must make sure that our spirit is connecting to the right spirit. The wrong spirit will speak the wrong things and cause us to make the wrong choices for our soul. We must try spirits with the sound doctrine of the Word. When it does not reflect the Word of God, it's not from God. Every spirit must be tried! This is the only way to protect our soul from destruction. If it hinders us or leads us astray, it must be avoided. This keeps our spirit strong and our will or soul submitted to God. Submission to God allows our body to stay under His control to bring Him the glory that He deserves.
