- 2019 is the year of correction. With the onslaught of false beliefs and carnality in the church, it's time for the church to be corrected. *1Pet. 4:5 Who shall give account to him that is ready to judge the quick and the dead.*
- Jesus is the head of the church so it's His Word that will do the correcting. *Eph. 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.*
- Things that have been done by habit, by example, or by ambition must be corrected so that God's power can help His people. *Titus 1:13 This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith;*



- Correction of the church starts with the born again experience. We must first make sure we are in the faith in order to proceed. *2Cor. 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?*
- Many have made a head decision because it's right to do, but their heart is still shackled by the world. *Heb. 10:39 But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.*
- In order to truly be in Christ, you must first deny yourself. You cannot just claim Him. *Is. 29:13 Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near me with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men:*



- The misconception of being in the church and not being the church will be addressed by the head of the church. *Rev. 3:16 So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.*
- How can we continue to represent the world and not represent our Savior to the world? *2Cor. 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,*
- If we are truly born again, we should be a light in dark places and not have dark places within. *1John 1:6 If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:*

1Pet. 4:15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or as a thief, or as an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters.

1Pet. 4:16 Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf.

1Pet. 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?

1Pet. 4:18 And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear?

1Pet. 4:19 Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.
