

• another term for disbelief.

- There is no salvation without believing in the full truth of God's Word and that man Jesus! John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- The devil has created a system of inducing people with disbelief. People that once believed are doubting God's Word and turning to other false beliefs. 2Th. 2:3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;
- Men are infusing race, skin color, native origin, etc. with the Word, which is causing a mixture of belief systems and the loss of faith in the one true creator of all things. 2Th. 2:11 And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:




- Fatherlessness is the cause of this uprising. Immorality produces unwanted children which causes many of them to undertake a quest for their purpose and feelings of worth. Col. 3:21 Fathers, provoke not your children to anger, lest they be discouraged.
- Hurting people hurt people. When the children of disobedience feel neglected, unwanted, or abandoned by those that teach Christian principles, their wounds cause them to lash out against the God of their parents. Eph. 2:2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:
- Youtube and other media platforms have given them easy access to false information concerning the Bible and its true origin. Their quest for knowledge is fulfilled quickly without understanding. Their faith is diminished and they are lost. 1Tim 1:6 From which some having swerved have turned aside unto vain jangling; Desiring to be teachers of the law; understanding neither what they say, nor whereof they affirm.



- God's remnant are those that do not waver in their belief in Him. We are not swayed by skin color, upbringings, societal norms, or unbiblical practices. The remnant sticks to the truth of God's Word. John 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.
- Sure many that have handled the Word have been deceitful and may have used it with questionable intent, but that doesn't change what is written and our faith in it. *2Tim. 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.*
- Though men fail us and can lead people astray, there will always be a remnant with true Godly people that will stand for God's truth no matter what. *1Kings* 19:18 Yet I have left me seven thousand in Israel, all the knees which have not bowed unto Baal, and every mouth which hath not kissed him.





Unbelief is a spirit and it comes to cause us to doubt God's existence and the truth of His Word. This spirit is fueled by our selfish plight to be wanted or accepted by the standards of our society. The creation roles from God gives us the purpose we need to be sure of ourselves and know why we were created. But, society has worked very hard to dismantle the home and make our careers and financial gain our worth! Nowadays, people do not even consider being homemakers or help meets. Men are not even looking for wives to keep their homes and children. Society has caused parents to feel that their social status is more important than their children's well-being. All of these things have created a pathway for unbelief to fester in the hearts and minds of the children. Because the parents sought the world, the children will seek it excessively. They will google their god and place their faith in themselves with no regard for the God of the Bible.



As God's remnant we must continue to teach the values of the Bible and shun the values of society. We must outgrow the need to be judged by our possessions and receive God's judgment of how our homes are operating. God's way is the only way to stand against this current wave of unbelief that has taken control of our communities. The church must get back to God's standard of living and child-rearing. When the children are cast away, the end has come because without a future, our world will perish.

Rom. 11:2 God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying,

Rom. 11:3 Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life.

Rom. 11:4 But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal.

Rom. 11:5 Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace.
